 - o Resolved STP issue

 - STP issues with wireless controllers addressed
 - o Firewall issues addressed
 - Previous objects added were conflicting with network devices.
 - Objects removed/adjusted to improve functionality.

- Lightspeed Filter removed from an inline configuration.
- Print server, DNS server, DC, and DHCP server failures due to March power outage:
 - o DNS, DHCP, and Print Server or workarounds in place.
 - Awaiting server equipment for DC rebuild.
- Plans for network overhaul are progressing; waiting to order gear and schedule a rebuild.
