Lycée Français de la Nouvelle-Orléans (Lycee Francais de la Nouvelle-Orleans, LFNO) is the free French immersion public charter school serving all of Louisiana. We are a type-2 charter school and French immersion program located in New Orleans. LFNO follows the French national curriculum and also adheres to aspects of the Louisiana state curriculum. We are accredited by the French Ministry of Education for French curriculum through grade 5 and continuously working towards accreditation for upper levels; accreditation is ongoing. For the 2017-2018 school year, LFNO serves Pre-K4 through 7th grade; a new grade level will be added every year up to 12th grade.

Mission: LFNO students will matriculate into the finest colleges and universities throughout the world. Lycée Français will provide the opportunity for its students to achieve both the French Baccalaureate and the Louisiana high school diploma in an academically challenging and culturally diverse educational environment.

- Ability to work collaboratively with diverse stakeholders—a board of directors, students and their parents, faculty and staff from diverse countries, Louisiana authorizers, French accreditors, and community partners—in a unique school setting

Key initiatives include:

- Developing an accredited high school that offers both the French baccalaureate and the Louisiana diploma

- Developing, through fundraising and grants, the financial resources to complete the renovation of the Priestley property
- Recruiting a diverse student population that reflects the broader community Lycée Français serves
- Recruiting faculty qualified to teach the French curriculum
- Ensuring continued financial stability of the school
- Continuing and expanding current academic and extracurricular programs
- Promoting relationships with diverse stakeholders
- Meeting and exceeding expectations of Louisiana authorizers and French accreditors
