



## **LFNO Lower elementary Grading Policy** **Distance learning - Trimester 1, Fall 2020**

- ❖ During Distance Learning, students will receive a minimum of 17 grades per trimester:
  - **A minimum of 8 grades for engagement, participation, and classwork in FRENCH and ELA - 50% of total grade**
  - **A minimum of 9 assessment grades - 50% of total grade**  
The following distribution will be applied: 3 grades in French, 3 grades in math, and 3 grades in ELA
- ❖ Elective courses (PE, Music, Art, and TOC) do not have assessments but are graded on engagement, participation, and effort.
- ❖ Grading rubrics (and assessment programs when relevant) are the following:
